

Sharps Injury Log

The OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard, *29 CFR part 1904, Recording and Reporting Occupational Injuries and Illness*, requires that employers who are required to maintain a log of occupational injuries and illnesses also to maintain a sharps injury log to record all percutaneous injuries from contaminated sharps. The information in the sharps injury log shall be recorded and maintained in a manner that protects the confidentiality of the injured employee. The purpose of this log is to help document, evaluate and identify problem devices or procedures that require attention. Per the recordkeeping standard, the sharps injury log must be retained for 5 years following the end of the calendar year that the records cover (www.osha.gov. March 2017).
